P A T I E N T I N F O R M A T I O N

The side effects listed below are those that occur most frequently. Other side effects may occur; please contact your doctor or oncology nurse to report any medical problems.

FASLODEX (Fulvestrant Injection)

- Indicated for hormone receptor-positive, metastatic breast cancer, in postmenopausal women, with disease progression following anti-estrogen therapy.
- Given as an IM (intramuscular injection) into the buttock.
- Given once every 4 weeks.

Side Effects

- Possible gastrointestinal symptoms, including nausea, vomiting, constipation, diarrhea, and abdominal discomfort may occur.
- Less common side effects include: headache, back pain, hot flashes, and pharyngitis (sore throat).
- Injection site reactions, including pain and inflammation.
