



## Dolasetron (Anzemet®)

Generic Name: dolasetron

Drug Name: Anzemet®

**Purpose:** Anzemet is used to lessen nausea and/or vomiting that occurs within 3 days after your chemotherapy or surgery. There are other medications that can be used to treat nausea or vomiting that begins more than 3 days after your chemotherapy treatment or surgery.

**Form:**

- Pill
- Intravenous (IV)

**How to take:**

- Anzemet may be given orally (by mouth) in pill form
  - Take Anzemet 30 – 60 minutes before eating if you are nauseous
- Anzemet may be given intravenously (into a vein)
  - Your doctor will determine your dose and schedule

**Possible Side Effects:**

- Headache
- Blurred vision
- Diarrhea
- Constipation
